## FOALING AND NEONATAL CARE

### FOALING OF MARE

\$ 400.00

(Includes: placement of a foal-alert transmitter and establishing the monitor system, attending/assisting with foaling, administration of enema and naval dip with betadine solution)

### NEONATAL CARE POST-FOALING

(Approximately 12 hours after foaling, the mare and foal will be examined by a veterinarian accordingly)

#### Foal exam includes:

IgG test	\$ 33.00
Ophthalmic, cardiac, respiratory, gastrointestinal, and joint exams	\$ 38.00
CBC, fibrinogen (optional)	\$ 65.00

#### Mare exam includes:

General physical exam	\$ 38.00
Rectal exam/ultrasound of reproductive tract	\$ 33.00
Speculum exam (optional)	\$ 30.00
Tubing with mineral oil (optional)	\$ 27.00

### BOARD FEES

\$ 22.75/day
