## CEM QUARANTINE TESTING

### For Non-Pregnant and Pregnant Mares

*DURATION OF QUARANTINE* 14 -18 days

*COMPLETE QUARANTINE BOARD AND CARE* ~\$ 575.00  
(Includes turnout in isolation paddock)

*VETERINARY COSTS* ~\$ 625.00

Required CEM test procedures include:

- (1) For pregnant mares, blood test the mare for CEM utilizing a CF test.
- (2) Culturing the clitoral fossa and sinuses, endometrium of uterus (not in pregnant mare), and cervix on Days 1, 4 and 7 of quarantine period.
- (3) On Day 7, clitoral sinuses are manually expressed and flushed with a cerumalytic compound.
- (4) After culturing is done, the external genitalia, vaginal vestibule, fossa and clitoral areas are all washed w/ 2% chlorhexidine surgical scrub, rinsed and coated w/ 0.2% nitrofurazone ointment for 5 consecutive days.

*LABORATORY FEES* ~\$ 225.00

Includes shipping and processing of at least 9 culture samples and 1 blood sample taken from the pregnant or nonpregnant mare.

*STATE FEES (VARIABLE)* ~\$ 750.00

Includes state veterinarian inspection of procedures (minimum of 3 times)

State fees are: \$29.00/hour and \$0.27/mile plus a 15% administration fee.

*If all cultures are negative, the mare can be released from quarantine after the washing and packing procedure is complete. This will be determined by the state veterinarian's office.*
