## FOALING AND NEONATAL CARE

### *FOALING OF MARE*

\$ 550.00

(Includes: placement of a foal-alert and establishing the monitor system, attending/assisting with foaling, administration of enema and naval dip with chlorhexidine solution)

### *NEONATAL CARE POST-FOALING*

(Approximately 12 hours after foaling, the mare and foal will be examined by a veterinarian accordingly)

#### Foal exam includes:

### *FOAL HANDLING/TRAINING*

A one time fee will be charged for halter breaking, leg lifting, and leading to/from paddock. \$ 110.00

\*(includes up to 6 flakes hay + 6 lbs of pelleted or textured feed per day. Additional amounts or specialty feeds will be charged at cost.)
