## **FOALING AND NEONATAL CARE**

### ***FOALING OF MARE***

**\$ 550.00**

(Includes: placement of a foal-alert and establishing the monitor system, attending/assisting with foaling, administration of enema and naval dip with chlorhexidine solution)

### ***NEONATAL CARE POST-FOALING***

(Approximately 12 hours after foaling, the mare and foal will be examined by a veterinarian accordingly)

#### Foal exam includes:

IgG test	<b>\$ 70.00</b>
Ophthalmic, cardiac, respiratory, gastrointestinal, and joint exams	<b>\$ 55.00</b>
CBC, fibrinogen (optional)	<b>\$ 110.00</b>

#### Mare exam includes:

General physical exam	<b>\$ 55.00</b>
Rectal exam/ultrasound of reproductive tract	<b>\$ 55.00</b>
Speculum exam (optional)	<b>\$ 40.00</b>
Tubing with mineral oil (optional)	<b>\$ 35.00</b>

### ***FOAL HANDLING/TRAINING***

A one time fee will be charged for halter breaking, leg lifting, and leading to/from paddock. **\$ 110.00**

Foal halter (if owner doesn't supply) **\$ 32.00**

### ***BOARD FEES\****

**\$ 31.50/day**

\*(includes up to 6 flakes hay + 6 lbs of pelleted or textured feed per day. Additional amounts or specialty feeds will be charged at cost.)
